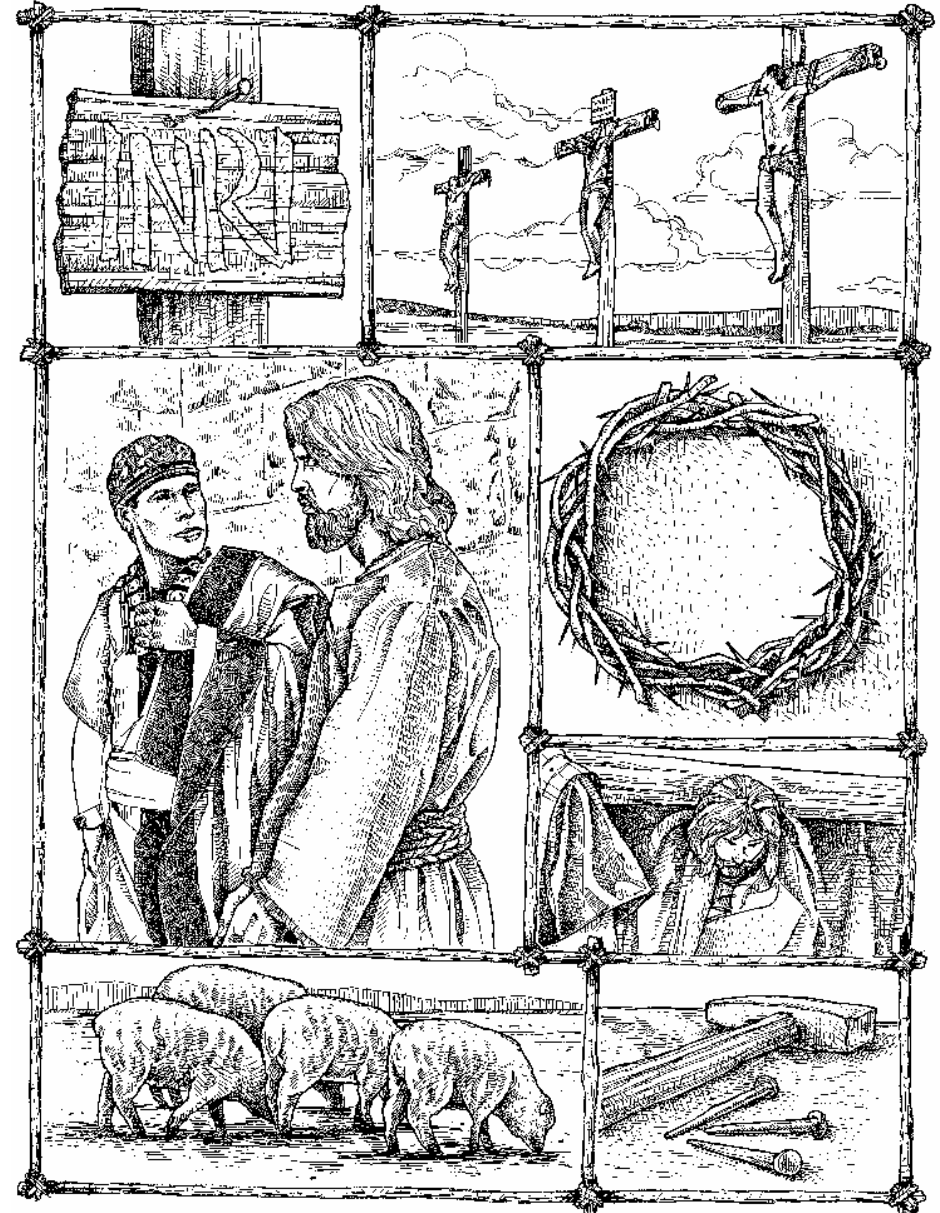

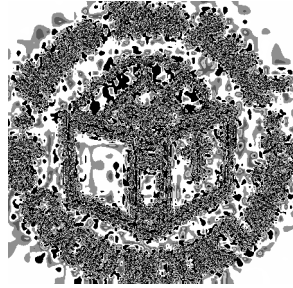

Bring the whole family and start your Good Friday off right with breakfast and fellowship at the Y. For tickets, contact Dale Hutchison at 724-285-4194.

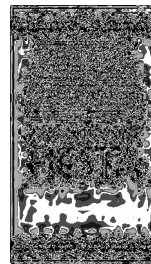

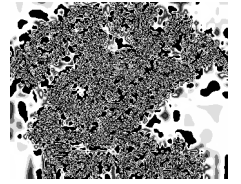
