The Hawks are looking for a reliable babysitter to work in their home three days a week. If you can recommend someone for this position, please give Denise a call at 724-287-6429.

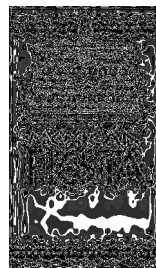
### Church Office Closed Monday and Tuesday

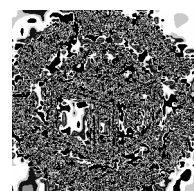
### Weckerly Corn Roast
