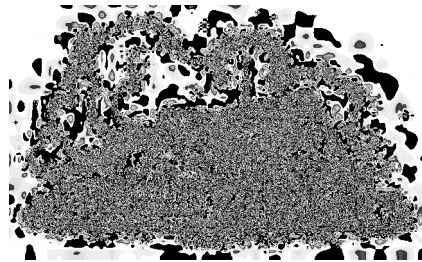

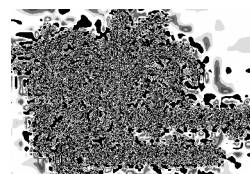
Today we celebrate the baptism of Lily Esther Hawks, born on April 20, 2006 to Denise and Dan Hawks

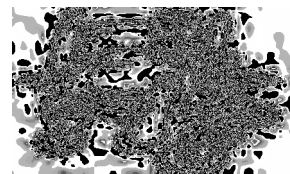
### Tender Tots Adds an Afternoon Class Classes Are Filling Up Fast

During the month of June, we will be collecting mission dollars for Forman Christian College in Lahore, Pakistan. Forman College was returned to our denomination in 2003, after being under the control of the Pakistan government for several decades.

Since 2003, significant changes have occurred. The number of Christians on the 165 member faculty has grown from 4 to

65. The number of Christian students has grown from 20 to several hundred. But there is much rebuilding left to be done.

Maintaining a Christian witness and presence in a country where only 2% of the population is Christian is vital. We can help!
