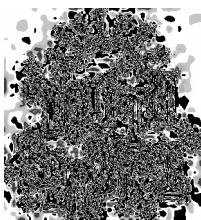

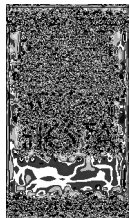
### Youth Sunday Next Week!

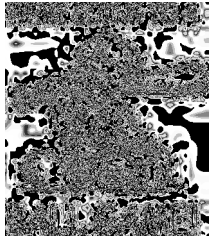

**Friday, June 16, at 7:05**

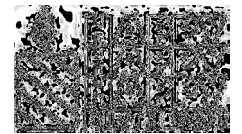
