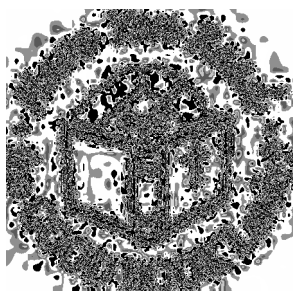

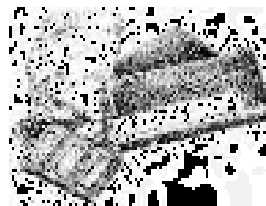
### I Can't Believe I Read the Whole Thing!

## Katie' Garden Needs Your Help

Trinity Lutheran Church is developing Katie' Garden for the purpose of growing fresh fruits and vegetables to be used in the Butler area Community Dinner program. The produce from this garden will go first to Katie's Kitchen, the Thursday evening Community Dinner, and then to the other dinners in the area.

Katie's Garden is 5000 square feet and will be divided into 40 raised beds surrounded by a border of flowers. They have already planted 8 apple trees and in the fall a 100-foot grape trellis will be installed.

Do you enjoy gardening? Would you like to meet other gardeners from this area and help feed those people from Butler most in need?

The Trinity Lutheran Church hopes to divide the work by assigning small groups of people to be responsible for one or more of the beds. There are many different jobs available. Preparing the beds, planting, weeding, pruning, etc. Many Hands Make Light Work!
