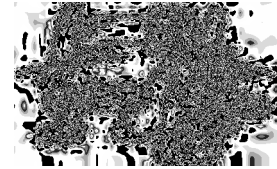
**Correction! Correction! Correction! Correction! Correction!

Dinner with Friends to Meet in June

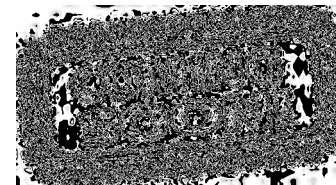
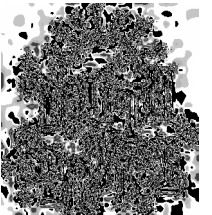

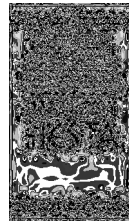
It's Time For A Picnic!

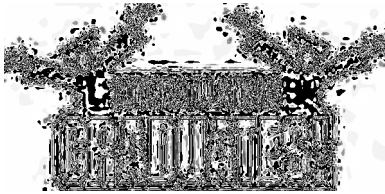

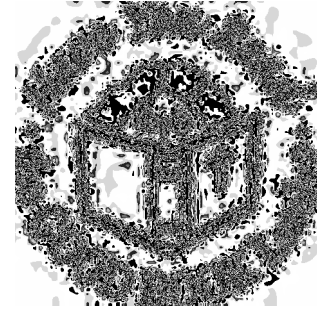


Calling All Grads!!
