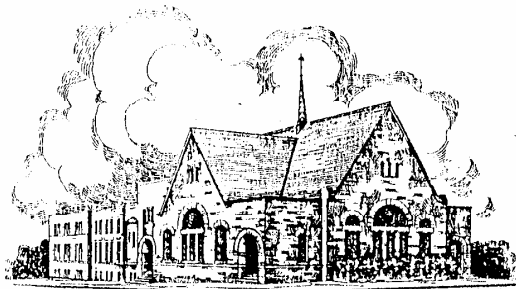

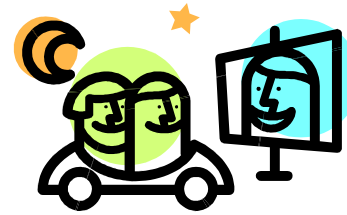
DINNER WITH FRIENDS
